GUILD PROJECTS TO CHOOSE FROM ARE (Choose three from these groups)

Limited Committees: First Come, First Served

Poinsettia Sales/Delivery (Must be able to deliver plants around 9:00 am until all plants are delivered on a weekday in late Nov/early Dec.) - Help with customer lists, mail outs, plant delivery, phone calling, unloading of plants from the wholesaler when they arrive, etc.

Membership - Help with annual membership drive May - August

Children's Concerts Docent - Help coordinate docents or serve as a docent for approximately 4 hours

Children's Concerts Hospitality - Provide nominal funds for committee chairs to purchase food to feed musicians (amount to be determined based on number of musicians and number of committee members)

Fall Concert Hospitality - Help with donating/serving food to the musicians during rehearsals/day of concert

Winter Concert Hospitality - Help with donating/serving food to the musicians during rehearsals/day of concert

Cotillion (Etiquette/manners program for young men and women in grades 8, 9, 10) – chaperone/ help with a session, provide hospitality, provide small prize gifts for sessions, etc.

Debutante - Assist with workshops, hospitality, ball silent auction, presentation needs, etc.

Symphony Ball - Work on the committee to help select/determine venue, flowers, linens, caterer and decoration choices, coordinate table/seating reservations, work on publicity/signs, type up/coordinate the printed program, help coordinate the music needs for the evening, coordinate borrowed plants for décor, etc.
